<sup>^</sup> Although the UK has announced that they will no longer be taking part in the Erasmus programme post-Brexit, the existing agreements have been extended for a final year. No tuition fees will be payable, but the extent of the grant for living expenses needs to be clarified.

<sup>\*</sup>Note that for the duration of the Covid-19 travel restrictions, a semester studying in English in Geneva or Oulu **will also count** as the compulsory stay abroad despite the fact that these are not English-speaking countries.

  - give reasons for your choice of university; and
  - include examples of the kind of courses you would like to attend.

Your statement should be 1-2 pages long. Please note that it is very important for the selection process!

- **(b)** You should also prepare a short **CV** (1-2 -ages)
  - Both documents must be in English.
- (c) You also need to supply a **degree transcript** / a copy of your grades so far.
  - A PDF of the *Notenübersicht* from Stud.IP is enough the transcript doesn't need to be stamped by the Prüfungsamt at this stage.
  - Add any course grades you are still waiting for on a separate page.

### 2) Selection criteria:

The department's criteria for being selected for an Erasmus place are as follows. They will be applied in the order they are listed.

- a) Previously awarded an Erasmus place but unable to take advantage of it during to COVID-19.
  - Note: students in this situation must still submit a new application!
- b) Current Fachsemester you will generally need to be in your third or higher semester at the time of application. First semester students can occasionally be considered for the full-year Erasmus places at Edge Hill.
- c) Statement of Motivation this is particularly important!
- d) *Notenübersicht* the strength of your current grades, particularly in Anglistik/ Amerikanistik. If you are applying in your third semester and still have missing BM grades on your transcript, then please supply these on a separate piece of paper.
- e) English modules to complete you need to show EITHER that you have courses in your BA/MEd/MA that you could study in Britain/Ireland, OR be willing to complete courses that cannot be recognised in Oldenburg for the sake of the experience. (There is absolutely no guarantee that you can attend classes in your second subject at our partner universities.)
- f) Willingness to promote Oldenburg as a destination for future Erasmus students please include information about this in your statement of motivation.
