It is strongly recommended that independent applicants to the UK, Ireland and Malta and those studying at partner universities in the US and Canada, Australia/New Zealand, India, South Africa and elsewhere also complete a learning agreement in advance – it makes the credit transfer process when you get back much more efficient! (This form can also be used by Erasmus students to get approval for individual modules *before* submitting an official learning agreement and has been expanded as of late 2020 to cover all forms of online study completed as an alternative to going abroad.)
